NJB Uniform Policy Agreement

At schools where students are expected to dress in uniforms, student behavior AND student achievement are positively impacted by the wearing of uniforms. Uniforms are a positive and important part of building a safe and caring school environment.

Please support safety and success at New Joseph Bonnheim by following our school uniform policy. The table below outlines the appropriate type of clothing to be worn at NJB and some items we have noticed on some students that are not allowable.

In addition, please note the following:

- Coats and jackets do not have to be uniform colors, but outer/extra wear (see table) is different than a coat or jacket. Outerwear—multiple shirts, sweaters, or sweatshirts—worn all day must follow uniform colors.
- Tights do not have to follow uniform colors
- If scholars want to wear multiple shirts, all visible shirts must follow uniform policy.
- Hats cannot be worn inside the classroom.
- Pants may not sag; either pants fit appropriately or belts are worn to ensure adequate coverage.
- Jewelry that poses a safety risk or a distraction (ex. Hoop earrings, studs, large chains, pendants, makeup, fake nails and perfume/cologne are not allowed.
- Piercings other than one earning pierce on each lobe.
- Any kind of doo-rag or bandana will not be allowed
- Absolutely no color RED
